Thank goodness we are finally able to experience some beautiful weather and get outside! It really is a very pleasant way to end the week!

Whilst this has only been a 4 day week, we have still managed to pack so much in. We started the week with another fantastic 'Tell me Tuesday' presented by Mr Findley (Allana and Alexia's Dad) all about Coarse fishing. He provided some really interesting information about fishing including what types of fishing there are and how they are different from Coarse fishing which is 'catch and release' (I too didn't know that!). The children were really fascinated by the different equipment used and how it had different features to alert you to the presence of a fish including alarms and lights. The children were also incredibly impressed with pictures of not only the wide variety of fish that had been caught (and released) by Mr Findley and his brother but also the size!

This week we have had some more children who have been undertaking self-directed courageous advocacy activities to raise money for WaterAid. Clara, Martha and Scarlett made smoothies and asked their neighbours for donations whilst Olivia and Aubrey sold cookies and hair scrunchies. It really is amazing how motivated the children are and how important they realise the work of this charity is. As you will have seen, Mrs Gwilliam has sent out information about our upcoming bring and buy sales being organised by our amazing Year 5&6 UNICEF Ambassadors to raise money for WaterAid and to continue our journey to being a UNICEF Rights Respecting school.

As you know, we are well on the way to completing our Pond redevelopment project funded by FoSS and on the 10th June we have students from Sparsholt Agricultural college returning to undertake their final part of the project which involves the planting of a variety of plants that will thrive in the area. There is however some additional works that need to be done to bring the project to fruition prior to the planting including some general tidying/clearing of some areas and the laying of a membrane and then woodchips in the area that will be used as an outdoor classroom. Therefore, on Saturday 8th June 2024 we, in collaboration with FoSS, are looking for volunteers to join us to help get the works completed.
