Sparsholt Village Scarecrow Competition

Sparsholt Village is holding its first ever Scarecrow Competition next month. It is open to all residents of Sparsholt and pupils (please see whole school home learning challenge leaflet) of Sparsholt C of E Primary School.



The plan is that the Scarecrows will be made ready to display around the village, in people's gardens and outside the school, from the **1st October**.
