

Dear Parents and Carers,

I hope you all had a wonderful Easter break. The children have certainly come back to school full of enthusiasm and ready to learn - what a fabulous start to the Summer Term!

It may only be the end of the first week of the Summer Term, but we have already managed to fit in so many wonderful learning experiences for the children.

Our amazing Pupil Governors (School Council) met at the start of the week to discuss all of the amazing things that they are doing to help improve the school. They were delighted to see that their request for two new netball posts has been answered and are looking forward to shooting practice on the playground at break-times and lunch-times. They have also planned a fantastic, regal afternoon of Coronation activities to mark the crowning of King Charles III. Please keep your eyes peeled for a communication coming out very soon with details of this whole school event.

This week in Worship we have been thinking about "spring cleaning". The Pupil Worship Team talked about how over the Easter holidays lots of us "spring cleaned" our bedrooms and also our classrooms have been "spring cleaned" ready for the Summer Term. They told us that in biblical times, the Jewish people cleaned their houses before the Festival of Passover. We reflected on the Parable of The Lost Coin, in Luke's Gospel, Chapter 15. We thought about how in the story Jesus suggests God is like the woman and we are like the coin. We thought about when things go wrong in our lives and we feel "lost", God is always there and will "look" for us because we are so important to him.

On Thursday, our Year 5 pupils were invited to attend Winchester College's Primary Schools Artificial Intelligence Day. During the visit they participated in challenging activities which introduced the concepts and workings of Artificial Intelligence, as well as listening to a presentation about robotics delivered by Winchester College Head of Computer Science. All of the children thoroughly enjoyed the day and came back full of information about what they had seen.

We also had the talented students from Sparsholt Agricultural College come into school again on Thursday to present their final, detailed plans for the re-development of our pond area. Our children loved looking over all 8 of the proposed designs and will now work with Sparsholt Agricultural College students to select and amalgamate their favourite parts from the designs into one final concept for the pond. We very much hope that we can then start to turn this concept into a reality, with work on the pond commencing in the Summer Term. As always, projects such as these simply would not be possible without the support and incredible fundraising efforts of our amazing FoSS and our whole school community.

On Thursday afternoon, our courageous football team played away at Micheldever Primary School, with the match ending in a nail-biting 3-3 draw. It was a superb team effort, with all the children compassionately supporting and encouraging each other. Well done everyone!

As you will have seen from the e-mail you received on Wednesday, there will be some disruption to the school next week (Thursday 27<sup>th</sup> April) due to the strikes being held by the teaching union, The NEU. We have done our best to limit the disruption and would like to thank you all for your support and thank those of you who have already expressed your understanding.
