The fence around the play park in Woodman Close, Sparsholt is being replaced, starting on Monday 21st June 2021 and is expected to take up to 3 days. The play park will not be accessible during this time as it could be dangerous. There will be screening in place and closed signs posted. Please advise any children you have or care for not to use the play park until the works have been completed and the closed signs have been removed.

#### Beat that Louse

We have recently had a few cases of head lice reported. Please can you be extra vigilant over the weekend and check your children's hair. Although lice can be seen in dry hair, the best way to check is by the combing of wet hair with a fine toothed "detector" comb and treating if necessary, every three or four days for two weeks or until you cannot see any eggs. Treatment can either be by using over the counter treatments from the chemist, or the wet comb method and using lots of hair conditioner. Thank-you.

Due to the delay in easing lockdown restrictions, Winchester's secondary schools have sent through updates to their various transition events:

- The Westgate School Year 5 Open Morning
  - Year 5 parents should visit the Westgate School website to check the dates (week beginning 21st June) for virtual open events including a virtual tour and a film by Mrs Fyvie Rae. Year 6 pupils might like to watch this too.
- The Westgate School Year 6 Taster Days
  - Westgate will not be able to run Year 6 taster days scheduled for 6th and 7th July. Instead, they would like to return to the online taster lessons by Westgate teachers via MS teams, which they know pupils enjoyed last year. Westgate will be in touch with Year 6 parents shortly with some suggested dates and plans which they hope work for you too.
- The Westgate Year 6 Induction Evening 7th July
  - This will now be delivered online like last year. Parents will be sent a link shortly and be able to dial in with their children to meet their tutor and member of SLT, and to ask questions via Teams.
- The Kings School Year 6 Induction Days and Information Evening
  - Kings School has cancelled both events, and instead will be hosting a virtual Information Evening for parents on the Kings' YouTube channel. In addition, there will be an opportunity for new Year 7s to access short videos of introduction from the different departments, alongside a virtual tour of the school.
  - Kings School will be contacting parents directly to update and pass on any additional information regarding uniform and summer holiday activities.
- The Henry Beaufort Year 6 & Year 7 Transition Days 7<sup>th</sup> & 8th July


  Henry Beaufort School will no longer be going ahead with their planned transition days on the 7th and
