Dear Parents and Carers.

What a fabulous end to what has been a fantastic first half term. The children continue to astound me with their support and understanding of each other, how they celebrate difference and how amazingly inclusive they all are.

Today, our amazing Pupil Governors, which includes pupils from Years 1 to 6, did an amazing job of presenting their version of our School Improvement Plan to our adult Governors. They had all spent time before the meeting discussing the elements of school that they wanted to improve and then split themselves into groups, with each group discussing the 4 different sections of the School Improvement Plan: Quality of Education; Personal Development; Behaviour and Attitudes and Leadership and Management. Every member of the group spoke and explained what was already



happening towards each target and put forward their suggestions as to what they could do or what they needed to be able to continue to work towards achieving each of the targets. It really is amazing to see a Year 1 right the way up to a Year 6 child talking so confidently and passionately about the school and being able to articulate how they think it could be improved. Some of the key suggestions were around further resources to expand outdoor learning opportunities, online safety information sessions for parents, new football goals for the field and more maths based educational games.

The entrepreneurial skills in Beech Class were on show today with their Marmalade Sandwich sale in aid of UNICEF. The children had decided that they wanted to take part in the UNICEF initiative 'Postcards from Paddington' and came up with the ingenious idea of raising funds through selling their sandwiches. It was a roaring success and they managed to raise over £90.00. Even some of our Governors who were there for the Pupil Governor presentation partook in a sandwich and commented on how delicious they were.

Our target around developing our outdoor learning provision is continuing and we are very lucky as Sparsholt Agricultural College students have agreed to continue to help us with a few final elements in the pond area which we are so grateful for. We also have the Hampshire and Isle of Wight Trust in to work with certain classes on the 5th and 11th November which will be an amazing experience for the children and an excellent training opportunity for our staff.

This afternoon in Worship, as part of Black History month, the children have done an amazing job through both presentations and dramatizations of telling the other children about some figures in history who have achieved phenomenal things from Simone Biles, to Rosa Parks and Mary Seacole to Katherine Johnson. The children were fully engaged the whole way through and were impressed by what a difference these individuals had made.

Finally, please don't forget that on the first Monday back we have Marvellous Monday for all classes. This is such a fantastic opportunity for the children to be able to share all the amazing learning they have been doing with you as parents/carers. Parents and children will be able to come back into school at 3:35pm. Also, please don't forget that our Parent Evenings are taking place on the 12th and 14th of November and if you haven't already, please do make sure you book your appointment which can be done through Arbor. The instructions for this were sent out to all parents on Wednesday 23rd October.
