Dear Parent and Carers,

What a whirlwind of a week this has been both here in school and in the wider world.

The children have been a hive of activity in both their learning and courageous advocacy activities. Our Pupil Governors met at the start of the week to discuss everything from the plans for our Ash Wednesday Service, to their desire to raise funds for the British Red Cross to support the humanitarian crisis that is unfolding in Ukraine.

On Tuesday it was so wonderful to be able to welcome Willow and Beech parents back into school. Seeing the pride on the children's faces as they showed off their work and gave parents and carers their own personalised tour of the school was truly heart-warming. We are so looking forward to our KS2 parents and carers coming in after school today to see the amazing things that have been going on.

**Please can I remind all parents to book their appointments for our Virtual Parent Evenings which are taking place on Tuesday 8<sup>th</sup> March and Thursday 10<sup>th</sup> March 2022. All parents should have received an email on 18<sup>th</sup> February 2022 with instructions as to how to book. If you are having any issues, please do contact the office who will be able to help you.**

During the day on Wednesday, all classes had their first session with a cricket coach from Chance to Shine. We are incredibly lucky to have been offered a six-week programme enabling all children to learn cricket skills. Please can we ask that all children now come dressed in their PE kits on a Wednesday for the remainder of this term.

In the afternoon, we held our Ash Wednesday Service up in the hall led by Revd. Jax. Our worship team worked really hard to plan an engaging service with pupils from all classes taking part. During the service, the children talked about how whilst Lent can be about giving up something, it can also be about deciding to do something positive especially to help other people. The children came up with some wonderful ideas and it showed how caring and compassionate they are. Please encourage your children to take part in our 40-day Lent challenge and do let us know how helpful and kind they have been.

Reading, reading and more reading took place on Thursday in celebration of World Book Day. The creativity of our whole school community was so evident through the costumes children had put together and their favourite books they brought in. 'Drop everything and read' continued throughout the day with a bell indicating that whatever the children were doing they needed to stop in their tracks and read. Our House teams all met together with the House team leaders reading the children extracts from their favourite books. It was so wonderful seeing Year Rs sitting with Year 6s fully immersed in the stories being read. In the afternoon, our older pupils positioned themselves around the school and shared stories with the younger pupils. Again, the empathy and respect they all have for each other was so evident.

Compassion and understanding have also been abundant this week with the children's desire to help those affected by the unfolding situation in Ukraine. The children wanted so desperately to help and came up with the idea of asking for much needed items to support refugees affected by this crisis. The generosity of this community has been totally above anything we could have ever hoped for with people coming from far and wide to donate the most amazing items which will make such a difference.

Whilst we know that the coming few weeks and months are going to be difficult and unsettling, we are all so lucky to have such a supportive whole school community to help not only those directly affected but also to support each other.
