Dear Parents and Carers,

What a wonderful week this has been. The children have come back refreshed, the weather has been lovely and the positivity around the school is palpable. I have had the pleasure of spending lots of time in every classroom this week and have seen the high quality work all the children are producing due to their focus and determination.

I witnessed Willow class children writing about being superheroes including making their own superhero masks to disguise their identities. Beech class have been making the most of the outside areas to enhance their learning and demonstrate their excellent phonics knowledge. Maple class showed their excellent comprehension skills during a guided reading session linked to Charlie and the Chocolate Factory and I also had the pleasure of teaching in Maple and seeing their creativity when designing their own packaging for their chocolate bars. Rowan Class' focus has been on the Ancient Greeks and Oak showed excellent subject knowledge and understanding of the human digestive system. It was very impressive for children of their age!

Work has started this week on the pond area with the students from Sparsholt College (under the supervision of their tutor) coming from the College to work on the pond itself and the surrounding areas. They have already done an amazing job of clearing the huge root balls that have grown in the bottom of the pond and I have to say I am very pleased it was them and not me standing waist high in the water! They will be returning next week to carry on with the project.

We are very hopeful that per the last newsletter, we will be able to hold some whole school events in July although this is of course still very much dependent on the Government's decision around lifting restrictions.


