The meeting started by Sophia welcoming everyone and there was some friendly, 'how are you?' chat. We then all said our opening prayer together and lit a candle.


# Summer Term Parable Themes

We talked about the reason why Jesus told parables and we all agreed that the stories/parables that Jesus told help us understand his teachings and illustrate how we should live our lives in a Christian way. Revd Jax asked us to think about how our chosen parables were linked, Sam suggested that the common theme was 'compassion'. Revd Jax agreed and added,' the idea of love connects all of our chosen parables' and she asked us to think deeply about how love is played out in all of the parables. Sam asked Revd Jax which was her favourite parable, and she told us that it was the Prodigal Son. She said it was her favourite because the message is about God's unconditional love for us. It reminds us that it does not matter if we stray from God, or waste the gifts he has given us; he is always delighted when we turn back to Him.
