- You'll see on your Arbor homepage that there is an upcoming Guardian Consultation
- Your guardian consultations should be showing as 'Parent's evening 11th March to 13th March'
- Within the Guardian consultation you will be able to see that bookings ('self-scheduling') will be open from 5pm Wednesday 26th February and will close at 2pm on Friday 7th March
- Bookable slots will be available on Tuesday 11th March and Thursday 13th March
- Click on the **time slot** drop-down button and choose the 10-minute time slot you would like to book for your Parents Evening, and which Primary Guardians will be attending
- Please make sure that at least one guardian is ticked as attending, or you'll receive an error message
- The page will then reload and show that your booking has been successful
- You will be sent an email confirmation
