

'Fireworks and Festivals'

Dig deep and complete your jigsaw with courage,
compassion and creativity.



Recycle materials to create a 3D rocket.

Create your own firework picture.

Paint or collage a picture using 'hot' or 'cold' colours.
(Hot: red, yellow, orange.
Cold: blue, green, purple)

Create a set of 'Safety Instructions' to keep people safe during firework displays.

Go on a walk and look for seasonal changes, Take photos of what you notice. Present what you found in your own way.

Research a favourite animal and create a fact file about it.

Create a bug hotel in your garden. Keep a diary of the bugs you find.

Who is using your garden? Keep a watch out in your garden or park to see which birds are visiting.

Follow a recipe to make a special food for a celebration of your choice.

Choose a piece of the puzzle as your home learning and either bring your completed work into school or email photographs to the school office. When you have finished one of the activities, colour in that piece of the jigsaw to show you have done it. It is up to you how many you do and which one you do first.
