Dear Parents and Carers,

We have had yet another amazing week, which has continued to demonstrate the outstanding effort, empathy and dedication our children show. Our Pupil Worship team kick-started the week with an excellently researched and delivered presentation about climate change and how important it is to take action. They talked about the message 'one step greener' and highlighted many small changes we can all make now that will have a big impact on the future. They spoke passionately and clearly about the issues ensuring all the children understood and knew how to make a difference.

On Wednesday, our school football team played in a league match against St Francis school. Whilst the result did not go our way and it was at times a very tough match, Mr McGettigan reported that at no point did the children become despondent. In fact, right to the end they continued to work as a team, support each other and show a real passion for the game.

This week both Willow and Beech went out and about in Sparsholt Village to explore the local area. It was an absolute delight to receive an impassioned e-mail from a parent who had seen the children on their explorations and commented on what great ambassadors they were for our school.

Yesterday, Year 6 were lucky enough to be invited to Sparsholt College to take part in a kayaking session. The instructors commented on our children's excellent behaviours and enthusiasm.

This afternoon our reading buddy scheme was in full action. It was so amazing to watch the children support each other with their reading and witness their love of books and reading together.

The Pupil Worship Team have been busy putting together an update on the school's courageous advocacy activities so please look out for their letter.

Finally, as the temperatures continue to fall, can I please ask that all children are sent into school with a coat. In addition, on PE days please ensure children come dressed in non-branded navy blue or black jogging bottoms (not shorts), a PE T-shirt and either a PE hoodie or school jumper. We are still ensuring rooms are well ventilated and children can get cold when sitting in the classroom if they are not dressed appropriately.
