Rowan had the opportunity to both see and touch different species' tusks, fur, skin and scales and use their science skills and knowledge to undertake classification activities. Willow also had a fabulous time being wild explorers and looking at Meerkats, Giraffes, the Tropical house and the Tigers amongst other amazing species. The children came back looking exhausted, but it was clear that they all had a wonderful fun-filled day and couldn't stop talking about all that they had seen and done.

The children looked fantastic dressed in their Ancient Egyptian outfits and were able to learn all about life in Ancient Egypt including exploring multiple Ancient Egyptian artefacts and creating Ancient Egyptians menus. The children had a fantastic time learning about climbing techniques and safety and then putting this into practice. What was really lovely was that yet again the instructors commented on what incredible children we have, not only in their enthusiasm but the polite and sensible way they approached everything.

The fun and games continued yesterday with some additions being made to both Willow front playground and the main playground. We have had some new playground markings added to encourage not only more physical activity but also learning. 

#### **Core Christian Value Awards**



## **Important Notices**

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### 1. Year 5 and 6 Trip to Masjid Mosque – Wednesday 2<sup>nd</sup> April

The purpose of the visit is for the children to visit a place of worship as part of their study of Islam. The children will have a tour of the Mosque, observe Wudhu and Morning Prayer and take part in a Q & A session.

We will be travelling by coach leaving school around 10am and returning by the end of the school day. Please provide your child with a packed lunch, two drinks and a snack in a backpack. **Children should wear their school uniform.** 

#### 2. Beech Class Trip to Stubbington – Thursday 3rd April

We will be travelling by coach, leaving school at 9:00am. Please ensure that your child is in school by **8:45am** so that we can leave promptly. We will return before the end of the school day. The children will be exploring habitats and geographical features as well as taking part in teamwork activities.

The children should wear trousers (jeans, joggers or leggings are fine), with a long sleeved t-shirt and school sports hoodie or jumper. They **must** wear wellies, otherwise they **will not be able to take part** in the beach activity. Please let us know if this is a problem or if you have spare wellies that others can borrow for the day. Please also provide your child with a packed lunch and drink, together with a spare set of clothes (including comfortable shoes/trainers) in a backpack. They will be able to leave them in our base room during activities. We will be out in the open all day so a lightweight waterproof coat is also essential – we will still go even if it's raining!

#### 3. Clubs Timetable for Summer Term 2025

Please find the timetable of after-school clubs for the Summer Term below. Please remember that everyone must re-register for school clubs each term.

All school-run clubs will start w/c **Monday 28<sup>th</sup> April 2025**. For other clubs, please check with the relevant provider. **Upbeat, Mad Science, Junior & Senior Football Clubs, Artiology and Integr8 Dance** clubs are run by external companies. To book onto these, please contact the companies directly (information in the table).

For all school-run clubs (**Rounders** and **Cricket**) we will stipulate a maximum number of children. Places will be given on a first come – first served basis upon booking on our Arbor system. Arbor will require that payment for the club is made at the time of booking. **Bookings for clubs will open on Arbor at midday Saturday 29**<sup>th</sup> **March 2025.** 

The cost of school-run clubs will be £35 per term for 2024-2025 academic year. For this price, we commit to offering at least 10 sessions per term. If we are unable to meet this commitment (note – in the case of bad weather, we will run an indoor session covering the rules / tactics of the sport), we will reduce the price by £3.50 per session below the 10 sessions per term. In a term where we are able to provide more than 10 sessions, we will NOT charge anything additional. If all places are fully booked on Arbor, please contact the school office, where we will place your child on a waiting list.
