Important Notices

1. Hampshire Music Service – Brass Tuition for next academic year

We currently offer group Brass Tuition for children in Years 3 to 6 through Hampshire Music Service. The commitment to these lessons is for one academic year, with an expected cost for next year being £80 - £85 per term, payable termly in advance. This cost covers a minimum of 30 lessons per year, with lessons being at least 20 minutes in length (dependent on the size of the group). Group sizes are between 2 and 4 children.

This week the children were lucky enough to hear our brass teacher, Mr Potter, play some well-known songs in an assembly, and the brass version of "Baby Shark" proved to be very popular!

We wanted to give you one last opportunity to sign your child up for brass lessons for next academic year. We have to sign-up with Hampshire Music Service by the end of Tuesday 7th May, so if you would like your child to have brass lessons next year, please let us know before this date and we will take your email as a commitment for next year. Please be aware, however, that if we do not receive sufficient interest, we may not be able to offer these lessons.

2. Polite Reminder – School Uniform and Footwear

Please can you ensure that children are coming to school in the correct uniform each day. On non-PE days, uniform should include a school jumper or cardigan and suitable school shoes. Please refer to previous newsletters (on the school website) for clarification around class PE days. As a reminder, the correct school uniform is:

- Light blue short sleeved polo shirts
- Navy blue or charcoal grey tailored shorts, trousers, dresses or skirts grey or navy tights
- Light blue and white striped or checked dresses are acceptable for girls in summer
- A Sparsholt School jumper or cardigan displaying the school's mosaic emblem*
- Sensible blue or black leather shoes

*Please note that these uniform items without the school logo are also acceptable.

3. Polite Reminder – Earrings / Jewellery in school

This is just a reminder that if your child is wearing earrings to school, please can we ask that they are small, plain stud earrings. We have also noticed that some children are coming into school with other items of jewellery on e.g. bracelets – please can you remind your children that these should not be worn to school. Thank you for your understanding in this matter.
