Rev'd Jax then led a discussion about Lent as an important time for all Christians to clear their hearts out, to let God in and to make a spiritual commitment to God. Rev'd Jax then asked the Worship Team to think about what the meaning of the story of Jesus in the desert ,and what the story means. We talked with Rev'd Jax about because Jesus was alone in the wilderness, it gave Him time to become more spiritually attached to God.

Rev'd Jax then led an interesting discussion about what 'Temptation' means. We said it means wanting something that might not be good for us. Rev'd Jax asked us to give this some thought and to think about how we could explain what temptation means to the younger children.
