
Planned road closure

Woodman Lane from Dean Lane to Woodman Close and Watley Lane – Monday 22nd January to Tuesday 23rd January.

I am sure that many of you will have seen the road signs indicating that there will be a road closure through Sparsholt village on Monday and Tuesday next week. As a school we were not informed or provided any information in advance about this closure.

We have therefore been in contact with Openreach who have told us that they are expecting for there to be access throughout these days for our school. The work is not expected to start until 9:30am and so should not affect the start of the school day and should finish before home time. The bus company are also aware and have been told that there will be access for the bus.

If there are any issues on the day, we will raise this immediately with Openreach and try to resolve as quickly as possible. Thank you for your understanding with this matter - unfortunately it is outside of our control but hopefully you will not experience any difficulties on the day!



We are now using the Arbor Parent App!

This app will allow you as parents and carers to see all key information regarding your child / children e.g. attendance statistics, list of trips and clubs your child is registered for. We will also be able to send in-app messages to you to remind you about school events etc. Finally, in the coming weeks all payments will also move over to the Arbor App and replace SCOPAY - more details about this will follow shortly.

You should have received a separate email from Arbor this morning (Friday 19th Jan 2024) with your login details. For this system of communication to work effectively we really do need all our parents to sign-up to this app, so if you could please sign-up as soon as possible that would be much appreciated.

If there are any parents / carers who do not receive an e-mail, this is likely because the school does not hold a current email address for them. Therefore, if you are aware of anyone who would like access to the app but does not get sent a log-in, please encourage them to provide the school office with their e-mail address.

We hope you are looking forward to using this new feature as much as we are! Obviously this is a substantial change for the school office, and so please do bear with us over the next few weeks as we iron out any issues that arise. If you have any queries or concerns, please contact the school office.
