

We accept payments through the Government Tax Free Childcare Scheme and most other independent voucher schemes. Parents are asked to ensure payments are made by the stated due date to secure the continuation of their child's place. Should you wish to reduce sessions or withdraw from childcare completely, one calendar month's notice is required.

When setting up the account just search for Toast and Tea, Westgate – Scout Association, Scout Hut, Winchester, SO22 6RH on the Government website under 'add a childcare provider'. Your childcare voucher provider will want to know our OFSTED registration number, which is 2607487. Please make sure voucher payments are processed and cleared by the end of the month. We encourage Year R children to attend their sessions even if they are not yet in school full time.

Strong partnerships with parents and carers are central to everything we do. We encourage open communication and ask families to keep us informed of any changes to contact details, medical information or collection arrangements. By working together, we can ensure that every child receives the support they need to have a positive and enjoyable experience with us.

All Year Reception children will be allocated a Key Person (similar to nursery and pre-school settings) after the first few weeks of attending. We will let you know who your child's Key Person is in person. The role of a Key Person in a setting is much more than just a title. They will help your child to settle and will then be responsible for ensuring that the care your child receives meets all of their needs.

We look forward to welcoming your family to Toast & Tea and providing a safe, nurturing environment where your child can learn, play and thrive.

Toast & Tea first opened its doors in January 2019 with a simple idea in mind: "Children deserve the best" At Toast & Tea, we provide high-quality childcare in a safe, nurturing and welcoming environment. Our aim is to create a genuine "home from home" atmosphere where children feel happy, secure and valued.

At after School Club children are provided with a healthy snack and a freshly prepared hot meal. We work closely with families to accommodate allergies, dietary requirements and cultural preferences, ensuring that every child can enjoy mealtimes safely and comfortably. Our meals change each half term and we ask the children to help us to create our menus! Fees are charged monthly in advance. After School Club sessions cost £15.00. A one-off registration deposit of £30 is payable when your child joins. This will be deducted from your first invoice.

At Toast & Tea, children's wellbeing is our highest priority. We are OFSTED registered and all staff are fully DBS checked, safeguarding trained and committed to providing the highest standards of care. Secure sign-in and sign-out procedures are in place at every session, and children are only released to authorised adults. If there is a change to who is collecting please let us know via email with a password for collection.

We believe that children thrive when they are given opportunities to play, explore and build positive relationships. Our sessions are designed to encourage creativity, independence and confidence, while also providing a space where children can relax after a busy day at school. Through crafts, games, outdoor play and social activities, children are able to develop friendships and enjoy a sense of belonging within our club community.
