Create the counters and write simple rules.
Test it out on family or friends.

Take a walk around your local area and draw a map. Add simple features like shops, school etc. Add symbols and a simple key.

Keep a simple chart to record the day's weather for a week.

Create a family history box. Add old toys, pictures, post-cards—what is different/the same?

Draw or paint your own fantasy island and label its features e.g. mountains, hills, rivers. Write a set of instructions for a recipe.

Choose a piece of the puzzle as your home learning and either bring your completed work into school or email photographs to the school office. When you have finished one of the activities, colour in that piece of the jigsaw to show you have done it. It is up to you how many you do and which one you do first.
