4. Payment for keyboard, recorder and brass music tuition for Spring Term 2025

Please remember to put the recipient's full name and class on the envelope so that the Christmas Elves can make sure the cards get to the right children.

Governor Update

Julie Milburn (LEA Governor)

Whilst many of you will know me as Seb's mum (Year 6 pupil), I'm also the Local Education Authority (LEA) governor on the school's governing body.

There is a place for one Local Authority governor on the governing body of every school maintained by local authorities and we share all the legal responsibilities with the other members of the governing body. In Hampshire LEA governor nominations are made by County Councillors for schools in their division, who will seek to find a suitable nominee with the skills and attributes that the governing body feel will support and strengthen their work. In my case I'm part of the leadership team at your local further education college (Sparsholt College Group) and have a good understanding of the education landscape both locally and nationally.

As a qualified teacher the governing body appointed me to the Quality and Curriculum Committee (which I now chair). This committee advises the governing body on matters related to the curriculum, specifically looking at evidence of pupil progress and the quality of teaching. Monitoring of progress towards actions set out in the School Improvement Plan (SIP) Sparsholt Primary School - School Improvement Plan is also a key focus of this committee's work; this year we're focussing on further developing maths fluency, outdoor learning opportunities, improving whole school health and fitness and continuing to embed the children's understanding of global citizenship initiatives. You will be pleased to hear that we've made great progress already this year and are on track to complete all the milestone activities which were set for the Autumn term!
