

Oak Class - Half-term home learning

I have handed out the SPaG underground map and an A4 orange exercise book for you to use to recap and revise.

The SPaG Underground Map (Spelling, Punctuation, and Grammar) is a visual revision tool for KS2 that organises complex English rules into "tube lines," such as Punctuation, Word Classes, and Sentence Types. Please spend some time over half term re-capping/revising learning.

How to Use the Map

- Trace the Lines: Follow a specific "line" (e.g., the Punctuation line) to see how concepts like commas, brackets, and dashes connect.
- Identify Intersections: Some "stations" (topics) appear on multiple lines, showing how a word like an adverb can relate to both word classes and sentence structures.
- Check Knowledge: Pick a "station" on the map and try to define the term or use it in a sentence before checking the map's explanation.
