

Dear Parents and Carers,

What an amazing week we have had with every class being involved in some really wonderful curriculum trips and experiences. I am very proud to say that with every one, the providers have said what truly fantastic, polite, engaged and knowledgeable children we have. In addition, we had a Hampshire advisor in school on Tuesday who also commented on the extremely positive behaviours and attitudes shown by all of the children. They really are a credit to you as parents and to us as a school.

Willow and Beech had 'Jane the Baker' in school on Thursday who led some really amazing activities linked to the Great Fire of London and that historical era. She retold the story of the Great Fire of London and how it started, showed the children many historical artefacts and taught them games from that era. The children thoroughly enjoyed themselves and have even been seen recreating some of the games out on the playground!

Years 3, 4 and 5 were also out on Thursday with Years 4 & 5 visiting the Winchester Science centre to trial a new education programme that the Science centre will be offering to all schools from next year. The school were asked to participate due to the engagement the children had shown in previous trips. They thoroughly enjoyed themselves and fed their thoughts about what they had experienced back to the Science Centre staff.

Maple had an amazing day at Butser Ancient Farm where they experienced elements from the Bronze Age and Stone Age including seeing the types of housing in these time periods and how they were built. They even got to sit around a fire in one of the houses discussing life in the period including the lack of toilets! Making fences using some ancient techniques was one of the highlights.

Oak have had an activity packed day today having been on a Geography Field trip with staff from Winchester College. They have visited the Winchester Nature Reserve and St Catherine's Hill and have been doing map work, quadrats, land use field sketches and a survey and study of economic activity past and present all of which they found incredibly informative and interesting.

As you will have seen today, Creative Kidz, our after-school care provider, have now received their OFSTED registration which means they can now accept tax-free childcare and child care voucher payments. It also means that after Christmas they will be able to run sessions up until 6pm enabling further flexibility for working parents.


