



2023 KS2 SATs Results: Headline figures - Sparsholt Church of England Primary School

68.2% of Sparsholt pupils reached the new expected standard in reading, writing and mathematics with **18.2%** reaching the High Standard.

60.2% of pupils in Hampshire reached the new expected standard in reading, writing and mathematics with **8.6%** reaching the High Standard.

59.5% of pupils nationally reached the new expected standard in reading, writing and mathematics with **8.0%** reaching the High Standard.

Scaled Scores

Children receive a scaled score for each Key Stage 2 test. The scaled score runs from 80 to 120 with 100 as the expected standard. Sparsholt children achieved higher in all 3 subjects when compared to Hampshire and national figures.
